Getting to Martinique

The primary gateway to Martinique is Martinique Aimé Césaire International Airport (FDF). This modern, well-equipped airport is known for its efficient and courteous immigration services. Travelers will find several ATMs, currency exchange bureaus, and restaurants on-site.

An alternative route to Martinique involves **traveling via St. Lucia**, located just 18 miles away. Airlines servicing St. Lucia include InterCaribbean Airlines, American Airlines, Winair Windward Islands Airways, British Airways, Air Canada, JetBlue Airways, United Airlines, Qatar Airways, WestJet, KLM, Scandinavian Airlines, Saudi Airlines among others. From St. Lucia, visitors can reach Martinique by either plane or boat.


